Materials:

- Yarn in the colours of the pride flag you want to represent.
- Knitting needles and/or crochet hook in the size listed on the yarn wrappers.
- Tapestry needle
- Beads (optional)

Crochet triangles

Ch 32

1: Htr in second chain and across (31)

2: Htr2tg, htr to last 2 stiches, htr2tg (29)

Repeat row 2 until 3 stitches remain.

Htr3tg, fasten off.

Sew in ends.

Knitted triangles

Cast on 3 stitches

1: K

2: Kfb, k1, kfb (5)

3: K

4: Kfb, k to last stitch, kfb

5-6: K

Repeat rows 4-6 until the triangle reaches a size you are happy with.

K one more row, cast off.

Sew in ends, thread bead onto cast on end to add weight if desired.

To make up

Easy

With tapestry needle, thread thick cotton yarn (or similar) back and forth through stitches along top edge of triangles until all are threaded- this allows for adjustment of triangle positions after completion.

Intermediate

With crochet hook and yarn of choice, chain 40, (slip stitch across top of triangle, chain 20) until all triangles are on the chain, chain 40, tie off.
